Mr. Treado went on to say that since there hadn't really been much work being done over the last couple of months, inspections hadn't really been going on either. He went on to state that had Trustee Stankus given him the photo being discussed 2 months ago, it would have been immediately addressed. At this point inspections have not been completed because there is still currently work in progress, and more to the point this equipment in question is still not hooked up and functional yet. Mr. Treado stated that he would see to it by communicating with his electrical engineer to make any corrections or modifications that need to be made will be made.
